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Extracts from the Constitution* of Kirkconnel & Kelloholm Community Development Trust:

“Purposes

- 4 The organisation has been formed to benefit the community of Kirkconnel and Kelloholm ('the Community') with the following objects:
 - 4.1 The advancement of community development including the advancement of rural regeneration.
 - 4.2 The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage.
 - 4.3 The provision of recreational activities with the object of improving conditions of life for the persons for whom the activities are primarily intended.

Powers

- 5 The organisation has power to do anything which is calculated to further its purposes or is conducive or incidental to doing so.
- 6 No part of the income or property of the organisation may be paid or transferred (directly or indirectly) to the members - either in the course of the organisation's existence or on dissolution - except where this is done in direct furtherance of the organisation's charitable purposes.”

Qualifications for membership

- 11 Membership is open to any individual aged 16 or over who supports the objects and activities of the organisation.
- 12 Employees of the organisation are not eligible for membership.

Application for membership

- 13 Any person who wishes to become a member must sign a written application for membership; the application will then be considered by the board at its next board meeting.
- 14 The board may, at its discretion, refuse to admit any person to membership.
- 15 The board must notify each applicant promptly (in writing or by e-mail) of its decision on whether or not to admit him/her to membership.

Membership subscription

- 16 No membership subscription will be payable.”
